Why choose WINGS as your day program or SLS service agency?

- WINGS Day Program is located in Loveland.
- Day Program hours = Monday – Thursday 9:00-3:30, Friday evenings 4:00-8:00 p.m. On Friday nights we have special events—it's a wonderful time to socialize while accessing our community.
- Choose to attend the days and times that suit YOUR schedule
- We accept private pay (\$8.00 per hour).
- In addition to Day Program we offer individual SLS (supported living services) such as meal planning, shopping, cooking, cleaning, mentorship and respite.
- Talk to your case manager at Foothills Gateway to discuss your specific goals and needs.
- Transportation available.

A typical enriching week at the WINGS CENTER:

Socialization & Fun:

Games, Wii, bowling, friendship skill-building, Friday-night events such as hayrides, mini-golf, holiday-theme parties, salsa & hip-hop dance classes, games and dinners.

Health/Safety:

Exercise, weekly dance instruction, martial-arts class, educational health classes, swimming @ Chilson Center weekly, treadmill time, walks in the community, visiting parks & visiting speakers.

Volunteering weekly at the Habitat Thrift Store.

Creative Opportunities:

Art classes = 3x per week. Art Gallery on site.

Visiting art instructors: i.e., basket weaving, knitting, & various local artists.

Woodworking with non-electric tools
& other crafts.

Lifelong Learning:

computer work, academic worksheets, brain gym exercises, sign-language class, Spanish class, mind exercises, visiting the library, reading, visiting museums & other community places or tours. Guests visit us to share their expertise.
